Seattle, WA – June 5, 2020 – The candles will shimmer, the steaks will sizzle, and the piano will play as Fire & Vine Hospitality restaurants begin to welcome guests back to the company’s collection of iconic Pacific Northwest locations. Walla Walla-based locations opened on June 2nd, El Gaucho Tacoma will open on June 9th and Aerlume, AQUA by El Gaucho, El Gaucho Bellevue and Portland will follow on June 16th. El Gaucho Seattle will reopen in its new home at Union Stables when construction is complete in fall 2020. Hotel-based restaurants Miller’s Guild, The Lakehouse and Civility & Unrest are scheduled to reopen when occupancy levels increase.

New Hours and Reservation Policy: Fire & Vine Hospitality restaurants will reopen five nights a week. Location hours may vary but each serve dinner only from Tuesday – Saturday. In order to safely welcome each party, reservations will be required. Guests who arrive without reservations can add themselves to the waitlist via a QR code or on the reservation website.

Live Music: The tradition of live music at each El Gaucho location and AQUA by El Gaucho will continue, allowing guests to once again enjoy listening to jazz on the piano or Spanish guitar at our Portland location.

Revelers Club Rewards Extended: All Revelers Club members with birthday, anniversary and Revelers reward dollars set to expire between March 15 to July 19, 2020 are extended through August 17, 2020. Rewards will automatically reload during the week of June 8th.

Takeout Options Continue: Both [The Lakehouse](#) and [Walla Walla Steak Co.](#) will continue to offer their curbside pick up programs. El Gaucho will pause the steak to go program as the restaurants prepare to reopen.
